A practical review of the relevant legal provisions and guidelines, and evaluation of recent enforcement decisions, standard forms and contractual terms commonly used by MCSTs and Managing Agents, relating to personal data, will be provided.


Participants are expected to proactively engage in interactive discussions which may involve a mock negotiation scenario. All materials will be made available via powerpoint and/or Google Drive.
